### 3. Does Bosideng incorporate environmental and health standards in new product design?

Yes. The Group continues to enhance green product design and safety compliance. Environmental, health, and safety standards are applied during new product development, using clearly defined and industry-recognized principles such as Principles of Green Chemistry, Cradle to Cradle certification, and Organic certification. The Group has also built chemical-control standards into the formal product-development process and established strict mechanisms to ensure compliance and safety from the source. Currently, 159 chemicals used by the company are certified under OEKO-TEX® ECO PASSPORT.

In green design, the Group is promoting clear sustainability standards across the product lifecycle. Bosideng and the China Fashion & Color Association is co-leading the development of the Specifications for Circular Fashion Design, exploring circular-design principles and industry pathways. The Group also independently developed the G2G (Garment-to-Garment) closed-loop product CIRCULAR 3.0, achieving major breakthroughs in recyclable-material design and circular manufacturing. This product has won the ISPO Global Design Award and the Silver IDEA. The CIRCULAR 3.0 series is already in mass production and sold in offline stores.
