5. How does Bosideng manage political donations, charitable donations, and sponsorship activities to prevent them from being used for bribery or corruption?

Bosideng attaches great importance to compliance management for philanthropic activities and donations and strictly complies with applicable laws and regulations in the locations where it operates. The Group strictly prohibits political donations that violate the legal requirements of applicable countries or regions. All donations are unconditional public welfare donations. Bosideng resolutely rejects any form of kickback and strictly prohibits charitable funds or in-kind donations from being used for bribery, corruption, or political donations, thereby ensuring that charitable donations and public welfare activities comply with applicable legal requirements and ethical standards.

For charitable donations and sponsorship activities, the Group has established pre-review and approval mechanisms. It conducts necessary due diligence on recipients or partners, the purpose of donations or sponsorships, and the intended use of funds and materials. These measures are intended to prevent such activities from being used to obtain improper business benefits, influence decisions by governments or other relevant parties, or otherwise constitute bribery or corruption.

Relevant donation and sponsorship activities are subject to prescribed approval procedures and appropriate record retention. The Group does not implement projects involving conflicts of interest, unclear intended use of funds or materials, or other compliance risks.

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
